- ✓ Reverify benefits and obtain authorization and/or referral after treatment plan has been discussed, prior to initiation of treatment. Ensure appropriate signatures are obtained on all necessary forms.
- ✓ Perform financial counseling with all applicable patients prior to treatment, which includes patient financial obligations, billing practices and establishing payment arrangements.
- ✓ Record and maintains complete documentation of activities performed on account while in-house.

Requirements:

- One year of experience in billing or medical/dental office, knowledge of dental terminology, knowledge of guidelines and requirements for eligibility, coverage, and benefit claim practices.

Education Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED
